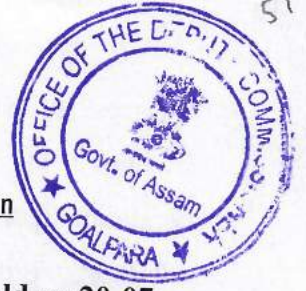

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Minutes of the meeting of District Development Committee, Goalpara held on 20-07-2022 from 11:30 AM in the Conference Hall of DC's Office, Goalpara

Members present- As per Annexure- A

Shri Khanindra Choudhury, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara presided over the meeting.

At the very outset, the Deputy Commissioner cum Chairman of DDC, Goalpara conveyed welcome to the all the members present in the meeting and took a short introduction of the Officials present in the meeting.

Initiating the discussion the Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara stated that all the departments must fulfil the visions of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam as introduced time to time. The Chairman, DDC Goalpara also stated that each & every directions/ schemes of the Govt. to be implemented in proper manner abiding by all Govt. rules within stipulated time period for the better development of the district. The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara further stated that the Govt. of Assam has launched some new visions like Precautionary Dose for Covid-19, Chief Minister's Institutional Plantation Programme etc. which are to be implemented as per Govt. directions within stipulated time period. Thereafter the Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed the DIO, NIC, Goalpara to explain detail procedure for implementation of Chief Minister's Institutional Plantation Programme scheme and accordingly the DIO, NIC described the procedure for implementation of CMIPP scheme.

Thereafter, the Chairman of DDC, Goalpara reviewed the progress of all the schemes of different departments, discussed inter departmental issues and resolved as under-

Health & Family Welfare

1. Initiating the review on the Department of Health & Family Welfare, the Deputy Commissioner asked the Joint Director of Health services, Goalpara about the steps taken for Post Flood Mega Vaccination Camp. The Chairman DDC, Goalpara instructed the Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara to take necessary steps for Medical Health Camp and necessary precautionary measures in the flood affected areas throughout the district.

2. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara to take necessary steps for completion of precautionary dose for Covid-19 throughout the district within stipulated time period. The Chairman DDC, Goalpara stated that special drive to be initiated for the precautionary dose for Covid-19 throughout the district to complete the task affectively. Awareness Camp should also be organised to motivate the people for Precautionary Dose for Covid-19. The Chairperson also instructed all Heads of departments to co-ordinate with the Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara to ensure precautionary dose for Covid-19 for the employees in their concerned departments.

3. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Joint Director of Health services, Goalpara to ensure preventive measures against Malaria and Hepatitis-B. Adequate Medical Team to be deployed for medical health Check-up throughout the district and precautionary measures to be taken against such diseases.

4. The Chairman instructed the Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara to submit progress report in the next DDC meeting.

Action: All HOD & Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara.

Handloom & Textile

1. Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textile informed the house that under "SAMARTH TRAINING PROGRAMME" 14 Nos. Of trainee weavers have completed 45 days of training programme and they have produced some fabrics.

2. Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textile informed that there is 1 (one) yarn Bank running at Office premises and 1 (one) at Dudhnoi daily bazaar. Through these yarn depot yarns are supplied to the weavers holding yarn passbook at 30% subsidy rate. But, in this month there is no sale of yarn as the yarn supplier of ARTFEED, Guwahati has not supplied Yarn till now, he informed. The matter has been communicated with the Managing Director ARTFEED, Guwahati.

3. Under the WEAVERS MUDRA SCHEME 10 (ten) numbers of proposal for MUDRA LOAN has been submitted to the Banks.

4. The Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textiles informed that there are 3 (three) Nos. Of Weavers Extension Service Unit and 1 No. Of sub unit in Goalpara district. From this unit yarns are supplied to the weavers for production of cloth. The weavers get wages for production of cloth, he informed.

5. The Asstt. Director, Handloom & Textiles informed that 48 (Forty Eight) numbers of beneficiaries have registered their names in Handloom Mark to exhibit and sale their products.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Asstt. Director to submit progress report in the next DDC Meeting.

Sericulture

1. The Asstt. Director. Sericulture informed that 120 Bighas of land is being encroached by 30 Nos. of families at Bhutlung Pahar area.

2. The Chairperson instructed the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Rev.), Goalpara and the Circle Officer, Rangjuli Rev. Circle to look into the matter and to take necessary steps accordingly. The Asstt. Director of Sericulture will liaise with the ADC and CO to resolve the issue immediately.

Action: Asstt. Director Sericulture & ADC(Rev.), CO (Rangjuli) Goalpara.

Fishery:

1. The DFDO, Goalpara informed that the work of Hygienic Fish Market will be completed by September, 2022.

The Chairperson, DDC, Goalpara instructed the DFDO, Goalpara to expedite the work for completion of the Hygienic Fish Market.

2. The DFDO, Goalpara submitted present status report of APART PROJECT in Goalpara District for the year 2021-22.

a. Under the activity for Carp-Mola Polyculture Demonstration, 2021-22, the physical achievement of Karipara Meen Palon Got, Matia is 50% and Bangaljhar Matshya Udpadan FPG, Kharmuja is also 50%.

b. Under the activity for Freshwater Prawn culture Demonstration, 2021-22, the physical achievement of Pakhritari Matshya Udpadan FPG, Kharmuza is 100% and Sadin Matshya Udpadan FPG, Kharmuza is 100%.

c. Under the activity for Climate Resilient Paddy cum Fish Culture, 2021-22, the physical achievement of Sonali Paddy cum Fish Culture FPG, Lakhipur is 100%, Kisan

Paddy cum Fish culture FPG, Kharmuza is 100% and Kalyan Paddy cum Fish Culture FPG, Kharmuza is also 100%.

d. Under the activity for Beel Fisheries Demonstration, 2021-22, the physical achievement for Borjong Beel Development Management Committee is 75% and Gosaibari Bheri Bheri Beel Development Committee is 10%.

3. The DFDO, Goalpara also submitted Physical and Financial Progress report under PMMSY 2020-21 (Central Share) and submitted Physical Target received under PMMSY 2020-21.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed all Circle Officers to review all the works of various scheme under Fishery Department under their respective jurisdiction and ensure early completion of the works. The compliance report will be submitted by the Circle Officers in next DDC meeting, the Chairman directed. The Chairman asked the DFDO, Goalpara whether there is any other project is being implemented at Urpad Beel. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Circle Officer, Balijana Revenue Circle to look into the matter to sort out the issues of Urpad Beel, if any. Detail report on Urpad Beel Project will be submitted by the DFDO, Goalpara in next DDC meeting, the Chairman instructed.

PWD(B)

1. The Executive Engineer, PWD (B) informed that the construction of Model School at Chatabari, Lakhipur for 2011-12, the work stopped due to sudden death of the contractor. Balance work estimate submitted to the higher authority for re-allotment, he stated.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara to communicate with the higher authority for re-allotment at the earliest.

2. The EE, PWD(B) informed the house that the work of the construction of ITI at Lakhipur (Nidhanpur) is being stopped by the contractor for more days. Several notices have been issued to the contractor to resume the work. In this connection, a court case is under process in the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court, Guwahati.

3. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Bishnu Rabha Auditorium at Dudhnoi is in progress and will be completed by August, 2022.

4. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Model Residential School at Kushdhuwa is in progress and will be completed by August, 2022.

5. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Secretariat Building of Rabha Hajong Autonomous Council is in progress.

6. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Sports Complex and Stadium at Dudhnoi is in progress.

7. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that regarding establishment of new Polytechnic, the work stopped by the contractor since last three months and notice served to the contractor to resume the work.

8. Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara stated that in respect of up-gradation of existing Hospitals for setting up of ICUs for treatment of COVID-19 patients under Assam Critical Care Project-2020 at Goalpara, the work stopped by the contractor since last two months and notice served to the contractor to resume the work.

9. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of New Model Woman College at Jaleswar is in progress.

10. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of District Science Centre at Goalpara is in progress. The Contractor has been instructed for early completion of the work, the EE informed.

11. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara stated that in respect of establishment of (i) 32/42 Bedded Paediatrics Care Unit, (ii) 10 Bedded Intensive Care Unit, (iii) RT PCR Laboratory and (iv) LMO tank with MGPS at District Hospital, the work has been completed.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings) to conduct a joint inspection with the Joint Director of Health Services, Goalpara.

12. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for repairing and renovation of PWD IB at Dolgoma in Goalpara Dist. has been completed and will be handed over soon.

13. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for Renovation and Construction of Inspection Bunglow PWD (NH) at Goalpara Dist. has been completed and will be handed over soon.

14. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Dudhnoi IB, Dudhnoi, Goalpara is in progress.
15. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Kasturba Gandhhi Balika Vidyalaya at Jaleswar HS School Campus is in progress.
16. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of RCC Office Building of Inspector of School GDC, Goalpara at Bhalukdubi, Goalpara is in progress and will be handed over by August, 2022.
17. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Sub-Centre at Khalsabhanga is in progress.
18. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of labour room at Rajmita Sub-Centre is in progress.
19. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the construction of Anganwadi Kendra at Jyotinagar Moktab LP School under Molandubi GP at Krishnai Dev. Block is in progress.
20. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of AWC at 141 No. Bualipara Tilapara is in progress.
21. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of AWC at Godhabori Muslimpara under Fofonga GP is in progress.
22. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of Anganawadi Kendra at Fofonga Majorpara under Fofonga GP, Krishnai is in progress.
23. The Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara informed that the work for construction of AWC at Dapkarbhita Chandamari AWC and Bapurbhita AWC could not be started as because the Social welfare Department could not provide land for construction of the AWC.

In this connection, the Chairman DDC, Goalpara instructed the District Social welfare Officer, Goalpara to discuss the matter with the concerned Circle Officer to sort out the problem. The Chairperson also instructed that the construction of the two AWC may be shifted to another location if land will not be provided.

The Chairman DDC, Goalpara instructed the Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara to ensure early completion of the works which are in progress. The Chairman stated that necessary support will be provided from the District Administration. The Chairman also instructed the Executive Engineer, PWD (Buildings), Goalpara to take immediate steps for handing over the completed buildings. The Chairperson, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Executive Engineer PWD(Buildings), Goalpara to submit detail progress report of all the works in next DDC meeting.

PWD(NH) :-

1. The EE, PWD (NH) informed that the works of Krishnai Bridge could not be completed by July, 2022 due to rainy season. The concerned contractor has been instructed to expedite the work and the work will be completed by August, 2022, the EE informed.

The Chairman DDC, Goalpara instructed the EE (NH) to expedite the works, because the condition of earlier existing bridge is not so good which may create untoward incident.

3. The EE PWD (NH) informed the house that under the project for Strengthening to NH-217 (new)/ NH-51 (old) from Km. 0/000 to Km 21/853 under Guwahati NH Division for the year 2020-21, 6.10 Km. of BC works and 11.00 Km of Micro surfacing works have been completed.

4. The Executive Engineer, PWD (NH), Goalpara informed that a project has been sanctioned recently on 23-03-2022 and under tendering process at office of the CE, PWD (NH works), Assam for Periodical renewal from Km 52/000 (Amjonga) to Km 73/000 (Dhupdhara), Km 134/000 (Airport Road) to Km 140/000, Km 141.325 to Km 141.825 and Km 146.00 to Km 146.227 on NH 17 under ARP for the year 2021-22 in the State of Assam in EPC mode.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the EE PWD (NH), Goalpara to submit progress report in next DDC meeting.

PWD(RR)

1. The EE, PWD (RR), Goalpara East and Dudhnoi TR Division informed that the preparation of estimate of damaged roads under Dudhnoi & Goalpara East Territorial Road Division, Goalpara has been submitted.

3. The Executive Engineer, Goalpara west and Jaleswar TRD informed that the works of 09 Bridges falling under Jaleswar & Goalpara West T.R. Divn are in progress. The

concern EE informed that out of above mentioned 09 Bridges, the works of 03 bridges have already been completed and the works of the remaining 6 bridges are going on simultaneously. Most the remaining works will be completed by December, 2022, he informed.

Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed the EE to fix the timeline for completion of the works immediately. The progress report with photography will be submitted in next DDC meeting, the Chairman, DDC instructed.

PHE

1. The EE, PHE, Goalpara informed the house that under the Retrofitting Schemes under JJM, FHTC sanctioned 47256 Nos., FHTC provided 46347 Nos., Water Users Committee formed 253 Nos. MoU signed with GPWSC-173 Nos. He also added that under the new schemes under JJM, FHTC provided 20289 Nos.
2. The Executive Engineer, PHE, Goalpara informed that Individual Household Latrines (IHHLs) under old SBM (G), Goalpara has been completed but under new HH IHHL (Phase-2), total Target 8126 and progress as per IMIS is 3362.
3. Under the SLWM activities, 3 Nos. Central MCF completed & 18 Nos. Mini MCF completed. He also added that four Blocks have been proposed for PWMU, namely Balijana, Krishnai, Kuchdhowa & Rangjuli Block. He again informed that for GOBARDHAN Project, site finalization done in Lela GP & DPR preparation is ongoing by the Technical Agency (M/s Urja Bio System Private Limited).

The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed to the Executive Engineer, PHE, Goalpara to submit detailed progress report in the next DDC meeting.

Water Resources

1. The EE, Water Resources, Goalpara informed that the erosion at Dhumergat area occurred due to the flash flood by river Ghagua. The work of temporary restoration of the river bank near Dhumergat HS School and PHC are going on by launching PSC porcupines to divert the channel flow and by launching Geo-bags of type-A and type-B on river bank. There is no major erosion at Baniyapara at present.

2. The EE, Water Resources, Goalpara informed that the repairing works of Chilarbhita embankment due to rain-cut, slumping down of slopes as a result of heavy rainfall, are completed. The damages of all other embankments are being repaired.

3. The EE, Water Resources, Goalpara informed that the vulnerable locations prone to erosion are already identified by the division and PSC porcupine members are launched to protect the areas at erosion site of Muzkuri of river Dudhnoi and Mowamari of river Brahmaputra to stop the erosion.

4. The EE, Water Resources, Goalpara submitted status report of various scheme are being implemented under the division.

The Chairman instructed the EE, Water Resources, Goalpara to complete all the pending works within stipulated time period and also instructed to submit progress report in next DDC meeting.

Agriculture:

1. Regarding syndicate at Darangiri Banana Market, the District Agricultural Officer, Goalpara informed that the matter has been discussed with the Addl. Deputy Commissioner (Agri), Goalpara and decision has been taken for joint visit at Darangiri Banana Market in 4th week of July, 2022.

2. Regarding arrangement for production of green fodder to meet requirement for cattle during flood, the DAO informed that the matter was discussed with District Veterinary Officer, Goalpara and he informed that sapling of fodder crop will be provided from the Departmental Farm and the same may be transplanted to the farmers field. Farmers will be organised from the Agricultural Department.

3. The DAO, Goalpara submitted status report of various scheme like- RKVY-RAFTAAR, DM, NFSM, BGREI, HMNEH, PMKSY, APART, ATMA and also Final Paddy Procurement report KMS 2021-22 1st Crop etc.

The Chairperson, DDC, Goalpara instructed the DAO, Goalpara to expedite the process for implementation of various schemes under Agricultural Department and to submit progress report in detail in next DDC meeting.

Education:

1. During review of Education Department, the Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Inspector of Schools, GDC, Goalpara and the District Project Engineer, SSA, Goalpara that schemes/ activities under Secondary Education and Sarba Siksha Abhijan Mission are to be completed within time limit. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara informed that the Govt. Of Assam has given emphasise to strengthening the educational system in the state and the Govt. Of Assam will take review on the various activities under Education Department. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed both, the Inspector of Schools, GDC, Goalpara and the District Project Engineer, SSA, Goalpara to submit progress report in detail in next DDC meeting.

Action: ADC (Edu.) & IS, Goalpara.

APDCL

The Deputy Commissioner instructed the AGM, APDCL to take all precautionary measures during this flood season so that no untoward incident can take place. The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed the AGM, APDCL, Goalpara to ensure immediate repairing of the default electrical lines, if lying, in the district. The AGM, APDCL, Goalpara has been instructed to submit compliance report in next DDC meeting.

Action: AGM, APDCL, Goalpara.

Animal Husbandry and Veterinary

The District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara informed the house that total 66,682 Nos. Of animals are affected during flood and Nos. Of animals treated 4502, total Nos. Of animal vaccinated 494 and Nos. Of animal lost/washed away during flood is 06. The District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara also informed that 16 Nos. Of Animal Treatment Camp have been organised during flood and 2157.34 Quintal feed (wheat bran) has been distributed. The District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara raised the issue of land encroachment under the Veterinary Department.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara to take up the issue of encroachment with the concerned Circle Officer and to submit detail land status/ encroachment in the next DDC meeting.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara to take preventive measures against the post flood animal diseases. Health Check-up Camp for the animals to be organised throughout the district to prevent animal diseases,

the Chairman, DDC, Goalpara added. The Compliance report to be submitted in next DDC meeting.

Action- District A.H & Veterinary Officer, Goalpara

Social Welfare:

The District Social Welfare Officer, Goalpara informed the house that 28,998 Nos. of beneficiaries have been enrolled in portal under PMMVY Scheme. Fund amounting to Rs.11,41,32,000/- has been transferred to the beneficiaries account through DBT system by the Govt. of India. He also informed that utilization of fund under Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan and one stop centre is under process.

The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed the DSWO, Goalpara to submit progress report of the schemes along with photographs in next DDC meeting.

Action - DSWO, Goalpara.

Panchayat & Rural Development:

During review of P& RD Department, the Chairman, DDC, Goalpara took performance report regarding implementation of PMAYG Scheme. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed the Deputy CEO, Zila Parishad, Goalpara to conduct awareness meeting among the public to motivate them on the scheme. The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed the BDO(s) to enquire against the beneficiaries who have not started construction of their house even after getting instalment under PMAYG scheme. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed Deputy CEO, Zila Parishad, Goalpara to direct the BDO(s) to expedite the work in implementation of the scheme. The Deputy Commissioner, Goalpara instructed all concerned to accelerate the work to be completed within stipulated time period.

The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed all Heads of Departments to complete all developmental works under their concerned department on time for better development of the district. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara also informed that the Chairman will conduct field visit to review progress of all scheme under all departments time to time.

Instructions by the Chairperson

1. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed all Head of Departments to ensure precautionary dose of COVID-19 vaccination of all frontline workers of their department.

2. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara instructed all HoDs to submit detail progress report and action taken report of all activities/schemes under their concerned departments in next DDC meeting. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara also instructed to all Heads of Departments to

submit list of all ongoing schemes/project under their concerned department in next DDC meeting.

3. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara informed the house that there will be a separate meeting to review the DRDA , Goalpara/Lakhipur Municipal Board, Banks and District Development Authority.

4. The Chairman, DDC, Goalpara informed the house that the DDC meeting will be convened on 6th day of every month and if the 6th day of the month is holiday then the DDC meeting will be held on next working day.

The next DDC meeting for the month of August, 2022 will be held on 7th September, 2022 due to holiday on 6th September, 2022.

Action- All HoD & DDC, Goalpara.


